**Rules and Regulations**

1. The Harrison County Open Youth Dairy Show is open to all qualifying youth participants (novice, 4-H, FFA) per KDA Rules. NO ADULT SHOWMEN
2. All animals must be on the grounds for check-in by 4:30 pm.
3. You must bring feed and water buckets.
4. No bucks or horned animals on the fair grounds.
5. Classes may be combined/or cut at the superintendent's discretion.
6. ABSOLUTELY NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
7. Danish premiums will be awarded to Harrison County 4-H members only.
8. All animals must have health papers. THE COMMITTEE HAS THE DISCRETION TO REFUSE ANIMALS WITH OBVIOUS HEALTH PROBLEMS FOR ALL CLASSES. Any animal showing obvious illness or unspecified signs of distress will be asked to leave.
9. All goats being shown by 4-H members must be owned by the member and identified by June 1, 2016.
10. No milk out before the show.

5. All animals must have health papers. THE COMMITTEE HAS THE DISCRETION TO REFUSE ANIMALS WITH OBVIOUS HEALTH PROBLEMS FOR ALL CLASSES.
6. All breeding goats being shown by 4-H/FFA members must be owned by the member and identified by June 1, 2016. Market Animals must be owned by May 18, 2016.
7. No intact males shown in market goat classes.
8. Must be tattooed and have proof of %
9. Bucks to be shown must be haltered, under control, or supervised at all times.
